John Burke finished his sixth year at the helm of the Rensselaer women's hockey program. During his tenure he has compiled a 102-68-15 overall record, which included a trip the the ECAC championship game this season. In addition to his duties at Rensselaer, Burke has also worked with many of the nation's elite players. He served as a coach at the USA Hockey Girls' Select camps from 2004 - 2009 in Rochester & Lake Placid, N.Y.

Prior to his post with the women's program Burke was an assistant coach with Rensselaer's men's team for eight years. Among his responsibilities were working with the goaltenders, defensemen and recruiting. He took over the head coaching duties of the women's team following the sudden death of then-head coach and close friend Bill Cahill. While serving the men's program, Burke helped the team to a 142-125-20 record and numerous players earned national recognition for their outstanding seasons including, 7 National All-American's, 3 Hobey Baker Finalist, 1 ECAC Player of the Year, 1 ECAC Goalie of the year and 4 went on to play in the NHL.

A native of Newton, Ma., Burke began his coaching career as the head coach at Worcester Academy in Massachusetts. In his lone season, he led the team to an 18-4-1 record and the 1993 Division II New England Prep School Championship, earning the league's Coach of the Year Award. He then spent the next two years as an assistant coach at Hamilton College in Clinton, N.Y., before joining RPI's staff in 1996. A 1991 graduate of Bowling Green University in Ohio, Burke was a member of the 1988 Central Collegiate Hockey Association (CCHA) Championship team and helped the Falcons qualify for three consecutive NCAA Tournaments.
